SOG: Stocking Medics

- \checkmark This SOG is written to outline the procedure for stocking the medics.
- ✓ The Officer in Charge or Senior Medical Provider of each run shall be responsible for adequately cleaning, re-stocking of items used during that run, and informing EMS officers of any stocking deficiencies.
- ✓ The EMS officers shall be responsible for making sure each medic is adequately cleaned, stocked, and organized.
- ✓ The EMS officers shall check stocking of each medic a minimum of 1 time a month using a check-off sheet that has been compiled and frequently updated by EMS officers based on stocking needs. (See Attachment)
- ✓ Medic compartments and/or bags may be "blue tagged" by EMS officers to aid in checking stock, as well as to comply with the state's "two lock" law.
- ✓ The "blue tag" may be removed from a compartment or bag for use during a run. The Officer in Charge or Senior Medical Provider must then notify an EMS officer that a "blue tag" has been removed.
- ✓ The EMS officer will restock and "re-tag" used compartment as soon as possible, or at next monthly check-off.
- ✓ If a "blue tag" is removed for training purposes, the person who removed the tag is to notify an EMS officer, who will then:
 - A) Check and "re-tag" used compartment or bag as soon as possible, or with next monthly check off.

B) Grant permission for that EMS provider to replace "blue tag."
